# New Roles in Teaching and Learning

## Return On Investment for Purdue Libraries?

- Renovated spaces in Libraries. Provost Office contributes \$1M to develop two new classrooms in Hicks Undergraduate Library, Summer 2012
  - Participation in other academic learning space projects on campus (residence halls, Honors College, Center for Student Excellence and Leadership
  - Participation in campus-wide conversations/recommendations for learning space needs and computing and technology needs for students



### New Roles in Reearch

Return On Investment for Purdue Libraries?

Vice Chancellor for Research contributes funding for positions in Libraries to further PURR implementation, Spring 2012

Librarians now involved earlier in the scholarly communication cycle, aligned with strategic plan

Successful data management plans for NSF proposals

Increased participation in campus-wide conversations on computing and technology needs of faculty
