




Collections





Collections

- Print to digital is gaining pace, and from bought to licensed materials.
- Changing collection development activities
 - Approval plans
 - Big deals
 - Consortial purchasing
 - Patron driven acquisition (PDA)
- Reducing on-site print collections
- Off-site collaborative print storage

Collections (cont.)

- Managing less traditional resources:
 - Institutional materials (reprints, preprints, others)
 - Datasets
 - Digital objects of greater variety
- Greater integration of digital resources with scholarly processes eg learning management systems





Spaces

- Reduction of on-site print collections.
- Remote collection storage
- Off site services such as acquisitions, cataloguing etc
- Re-engineering physical space for collaboration based on curriculum needs:
 - Among students
 - Between students and faculty
 - Between students and librarians
 - Between students and other service providers
 - Between students and technology
- Re-engineering physical space for other activities
 - Cultural events
 - Special events
 - Exhibitions etc.

Services

- Greater collaboration with other campus services eg IT, student support, language skills, learning skills etc.
- Embedded services human and resource
- An increased emphasis and role in e-learning
- Growing emphasis on tailored service to the "individual" – both faculty and students
- Self directed learning and service provision

Skills

- Evolving skill set with "fundamental library and informational skills" as a baseline
- Renewed focus on embedding library expertise more deeply in research and learning processes.
- Greater emphasis on creating, managing, and preserving digital resources – not just the libraries!
- Other skills: marketing, pedagogy, technology, negotiation, finance, space planning, interpersonal, collaborative, statistical analysis...
